

YORBA LINDA MIDDLE SCHOOL INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC UNIFORM INFORMATION

The YLMS "Bobcat" Marching Band uniform shall consist of the following:

1. Jacket/Pants/Hat/ Suspenders - school issued
2. Solid black, plain socks (no color bands)
3. Black marching shoes

The school provided uniform is a necessary item for participation in marching band. The student and the parent must realize that this uniform is an expensive article and must be treated with care and respect. Although no deposit is required, both the student and parent must be responsible for the uniform.

It will be necessary for the uniform to be dry-cleaned only! The student's shoes should be cleaned, polished if necessary, before every performance. Shoes are expected to look like they are new each performance!

A student will remain in the entire uniform (except hat which will be stored in its hatbox after the performance) BEFORE, DURING, and AFTER a performance. The marching uniform will be issued and collected before/after each performance. NO uniform is to go home! Students are to wear a white T-shirt and thin shorts underneath for every marching performance. The uniform may be carefully removed and hung on a hanger after the student has arrived back at school. NO eating or drinking (except water) will be allowed while wearing the uniform. This will prevent permanent staining of the uniform. Remember, whenever you are wearing the designated uniform of the Marching Bobcats, you are to present high standards of appearance and conduct at all times. You are representing yourself, your school, and your community!

YLMS Uniform Policies

These policies are set in place to ensure a professional looking group and apply to all instrumentalists.

1. The complete uniform should be worn at all times when in public.
2. Extra clothes are not to be stored in uniform bags.
3. Shoes are **not** permitted in the uniform bag. Shoes should be stored in their boxes.
4. A white t-shirt must be worn underneath the uniform.
5. No jewelry is to be worn during a marching performance
6. Hair should not touch the collar of the uniform. If hair is long enough to touch the collar, ponytails, braids, etc. are acceptable. Hair must be up the entire time while in uniform. When wearing the uniform hats, hair and bangs must be stuffed neatly into the hat.
7. No hair product should be used when wearing the uniform.
8. No eating or drinking will be permitted except water given by the chaperones while in uniform.
9. Uniforms must be hung properly on its hanger, placed neatly in the garment bag, and the hat returned to its box. The hatbox is made of plastic and will crack if it is sat on or thrown around.
10. Uniforms are **not** to be taken home.
